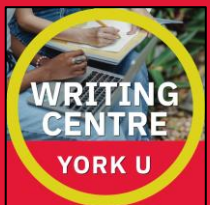

We can also support you in brainstorming ways to improve your writing and help you implement them.

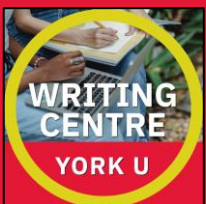

To sign up for tutoring sessions, appointments with our specialists, workshops and other offerings from the Writing Centre, you must be a registered user on the Writing Centre booking system.


